Walking through shadows

Ken Ham President AiG-USA

Note: Ken Ham's latest book, *Walking through Shadows*, poignantly describes his family's recent trials, as his beloved brother Robert, a dynamic young preacher of the Gospel, died a long, awful death from a rare degenerative brain disease. Below is a moving excerpt from Ken's personal story.

On the telephone 10,000 miles away, my sister described my brother's physical appearance: 'Do you remember those horrible pictures of prisoners from the concentration camps? Remember how thin they looked? Well, in a way, Robert reminds me of them.' This was the result of a degenerative brain disease, a type of dementia.

I wanted to see my younger brother at least one more time. He was so young—early forties. How could this be happening to him? I boarded a plane for 20 hours of flying—lots of time to reflect on the past and contemplate the future. A few hours after arriving in Australia, my heart began to race as I walked into the nursing home with my mother. I knew that no matter how hard I tried, I would not be prepared for what I was about to experience.

It was a pathetic sight. Robert was lying there, hardly moving. He showed very little (if any) signs of any recognition of his mother

and eldest brother. Mum tenderly stroked his forehead and then began the arduous task of trying to get him to swallow a special drink she had prepared for him.

He would swallow and then choke. Mum would wipe his face and wait for the next opportunity to get him to take another sip. Tears would run down my mother's face.


Why would a loving and all-powerful God allow a dedicated man of God to be struck down in the prime of life, with a dreadful, dehumanizing disease that caused him to lose his mental faculties and muscular function, and die slowly as his family watched, helpless to do anything?

Dust and ashes—the key to true hope

I often quote the Book of Job in my talks on Genesis. But you know one of the most important things we learn from the Book of Job? We find God asks Job a series of questions: Do you know this, Job? What about this? God uses example after example to finally bring Job to the point in Job 42 where we read:

'Then Job replied to the LORD: "I know that you can do all things; no plan of yours can be thwarted. ... Surely I spoke of things I did not understand, things too wonderful



for me to know. ... Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes" '(Job 42:1–6).

Basically, this is the answer to the issue of death and suffering. Job acknowledged that compared to what God knows, he knew nothing. He repented of his human arrogance and totally submitted his life to the all-knowing sovereign God.

The bottom line is that we are not going to have all the answers as to why things like Rob's sickness have been allowed to happen. Only God knows everything—we are just fallible human beings who, like Job, need to recognize that we know nothing compared to what God knows.

The Bible's account of origins in Genesis, however, does make sense of the world around us. This has greatly helped me in dealing with the issue of death and suffering. God's Word tells us clearly where death and sickness originated. We understand we live in a fallen world. Every person needs to be

spiritually healed, and total healing doesn't come until we leave this sin-cursed universe.

God has a sovereign plan far greater than we could imagine. Thus, we need to put our trust in God's Word and the fact that He is in total control. 'He is the LORD; let him do what is good in his eyes' (1 Sam. 3:18).

At the end of my visit to the nursing home, knowing that this could be my final goodbye to Robert, I bent over and kissed him on his forehead, 'Goodbye, Robert. I love you, brother.' I left the room somewhat choked up but with a real peace that came over me knowing he was the Lord's; and in the Lord's hand. I weep, but not as others who don't have this wonderful sure hope of eternal life.

Yes, sickness, suffering and death is a normal part of this life. But: 'Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort' (2 Cor. 1:3).

Pastor Robert Ham, younger brother of AiG-US President, Ken Ham, passed away in Australia on 7 June. Many AiG supporters worldwide had been praying for Robert, his wife Brenda, their two sons and the rest of the Ham family.

In God's perfect timing, Ken was able to see his brother just before he passed away, and also spoke at his memorial service in Queensland. You can listen to Ken pay tribute to his brother right on your computer—when you go to www.AnswersInGenesis.org/rhservice.

Museum receives GREEN light!

'Now it's fullspeed ahead!'

Soon we'll be pouring concrete for the museum's foundation!

The Creation Museum project is humming along! We have successfully completed all of our preliminary permit requirements and have our 'site plan' approval in hand! The construction activity at the site has increased dramatically, and we anticipate a very busy summer and fall.

Our construction manager, Kevin Markesbery, has been enduring Northern Kentucky's summer heat while he oversees the installation of underground utilities on the site. While we have been accepting bids for the paving, Kevin has been working with the steel manufacturing company. Soon we hope to begin laying asphalt for the entrance and parking lot, and pouring concrete for the building's foundations!

Intense behind-the-scenes work at the AiG main office is commencing as well. Our museum design director, Patrick Marsh, is making incredible models and drawings for the storyline and exhibits. (An update on museum design will be featured next month.)

Our 'gifts-in-kind' team—Skip Tilton and Sharon Mardis—has been working around the clock coordinating the many wonderful mission teams who have come to help us this summer. The volunteers have helped to move our museum materials and our order fulfillment (i.e. books, tapes, etc.) operation into one huge warehouse—in the same building as our headquarters facility.

Among our industrious helpers are Edgar and Marilyn Nernberg, who made the long trip from Canada to help for about six months!

In addition, most of the museum material—including Buddy Davis's dinosaurs and 17 truckloads of exhibit objects and supplies—were moved from storage facilities in Ohio to our warehouse here in Florence. With everything close at hand, AiG will now enjoy considerable savings and smoother management! Praise the Lord, we are finally all under one roof!

Meanwhile, the capital campaign team—Jared Vallorani and Lois Savage—has been very busy planning banquets for the fall—Denver (September 7), Seattle (October 12) and Atlanta (November 23, tentative). Ken Ham will give an up-close look at the plans for the museum.





Pat Robertson, well-known as the founder of the Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN-TV) and host of the '700 Club' program, recently criticized people who insist that the Bible teaches Creation in six 24-hour days.

Robertson commented during a 17 June broadcast: 'We could be looking at a solar day; we could be looking at a universal day; we could be looking at a galactic day. It doesn't have to be one revolution of the Earth. ...

'Genesis was never intended as a science textbook. ... We know now the sun doesn't rise and the sun doesn't set. But the Bible talks about "from the rising of the sun to the going down of the same." But it's poetical language. ... And to stake your whole faith on the basis of misinterpretation of poetry, to me, is a mistake. ...'

Robertson was speaking about Michael Farris, president of Patrick Henry College in Virginia, who was denied accreditation because he requires his teachers to teach a six-day Creation. He concluded, 'If Mike wants to go to court, he will win a court fight. But I sure wish he'd get off that 6/24 business.'

Sadly, many Christian leaders fail to recognize that an attack on the 'six days' of Creation is an attack on the authority of the Bible, and it undermines the historical basis for the Gospel that these leaders proclaim.

Dr Jonathan Sarfati of AiG wrote a devastating critique of the magazine article (read it at www.AnswersIn Genesis.org/sciam).

In the article and TV program, nothing new was offered that has not already been fully addressed on our Web site and other places. Furthermore, both outlets displayed a glaring ignorance of the creationist arguments.

In addition, *Scientific American* has a history of misreporting creation/evolution issues,

including last March when it falsely stated that Kansas had 'eliminated' evolution from the state's science guidelines. *National Geographic* magazine has fared no better—remember its false claim in 1999 about finding a missing link (a 'feathered dinosaur') that turned out to be a hoax?

Retirement accounts—a way to give

Recently there has been increasing interest in using 'retirement accounts' as a source of giving to a non-profit organization. Retirement accounts, including those of qualified retirement plans—such as 401(k) and KEOGH plans—and individual retirement accounts (IRAs) are different from other assets. At death, they are subject not only to the estate tax, but also income tax.


If a person is going to make

a charitable bequest, it is usually better to transfer the taxable assets to a tax-exempt charity and to transfer the non-taxable assets to the heirs. Because of the taxable nature of retirement plan distributions, they are an excellent source for charitable bequests, helping to avoid both estate and income taxes that would otherwise be paid if the assets were distributed directly to family members.

The majority—always right?

Did you know that there have been many instances where the majority of people used to believe something, but modern science eventually found they were wrong?

The majority opinion should *never* be used as a basis for determining truth. Really, the only absolute authority we have is the Word of God—beginning with Genesis.
